The Canyon County Children's Chorus (CCCC) is part of the Music Association of Canyon County (MACC), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. Our mission is to:

Enhance children's lives through distinguished choral music education and meaningful performance opportunities.

CCCC is a tuition-based program committed to making participation accessible to children from all economic backgrounds. Scholarships and other forms of financial assistance are available for families with demonstrated need.

To help keep membership affordable, a significant portion of CCCC's operating budget comes from tax-deductible community donations and fundraising efforts.

Scholarship Awards

Scholarship funds are limited and awarded to applicants who (1) submit all required materials by the deadline, and (2) demonstrate the greatest financial need.

Scholarship amounts may vary from year to year depending on available funding.

Required Application Materials (due September 1, 2026)

To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must submit the following by the stated deadline:

1. **Scholarship Application (3 pages)**
2. **Required Documentation (proof of income)**

Important Information

- Applications received after the deadline may not be considered.
- The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and notify families of scholarship awards before the first rehearsal.
- A new application and supporting documents must be submitted each year.
- Receiving a scholarship in previous years does not guarantee future awards.

Families are expected to pay any remaining tuition balance not covered by the scholarship. Remaining balances are due within 30 days of receiving the scholarship award notification.

If my child withdraws from the program before the end of the choral year, I understand that I may be responsible for the remaining tuition balance.
